Casual Position Arena Attendant/Equipment Operator/Labourer

The Township of Ignace is accepting applications for the casual position of Arena Attendant/Equipment Operator/Labourer with the Township of Ignace Parks and Recreation and Public Works Department. Candidates are expected to make themselves available for work on short notice.

Candidates must have the following minimum qualifications

- Experience in cleaning and maintaining indoor facilities like arenas
- Understanding of refrigeration equipment and the operation of that equipment
- Experience in cleaning and maintaining outdoor facilities like parks, sports fields, cemeteries and beaches
- Experience operating light equipment like riding mowers, snow blowers, etc.
- Experience operating heavy equipment (loader/backhoe/grader/truck)
- Good communication skills both written and oral
- Must be self-motivated and able to work independently or in a team
- Must be physically fit since physical labour is required
- Full "G" class Driver's License required.
- Vulnerable Sector Police clearance is required

An Ontario Class DZ Driver's License must be obtained. Certification in Standard First Aid and CPR and a Class B Refrigeration certificate would be an asset. Experience in municipalities performing a variety of public works and/or parks and recreation functions is highly desirable.
